NO TICKETS ARE REQUIRED

Doors will open at 12pm.

The graduation ceremony will begin promptly at 1:00pm and should last approximately 2 hours.

Families and guests of the graduates are to park in the C-2 and surrounding lots located on the East side of the building and enter through the main entrance on the south end of the building. See the Cintas Center map for more information and details regarding handicap accessibility.

There will be parking lot attendants and ushers inside the building to help with directions.

Lifetouch, the official Loveland High School photographer, will be present at the Cintas Center taking pictures of every graduate as he/she receives a diploma. Portraits will be available online at events.lifetouch.com approximately ten days after the ceremony. Celebrate this achievement with these professional portraits.”

The senior class has paid a fee to have seniors’ names and pictures projected on the big scoreboard as their diplomas are received.

EVERY GRADUATE will have a Graduation Program on his/her seat in the arena as a keepsake.

Seniors will have business to attend to before and after the ceremony. In order to avoid confusion and congestion, parents and guests are not to enter areas outside of the main arena. It would be best to make arrangements to meet your graduate after the ceremony in a designated area in the FRONT of the Cintas Center.

This is a dignified occasion and we ask that both graduates and guests conduct themselves accordingly.

The only cords or adornments permitted to be worn on graduation robes are those given by Loveland High School or Great Oaks.

Parking Information

Parking spaces

The Cintas Center features 2,150 spaces around the building with another 1,200 spaces within a short walking distance.

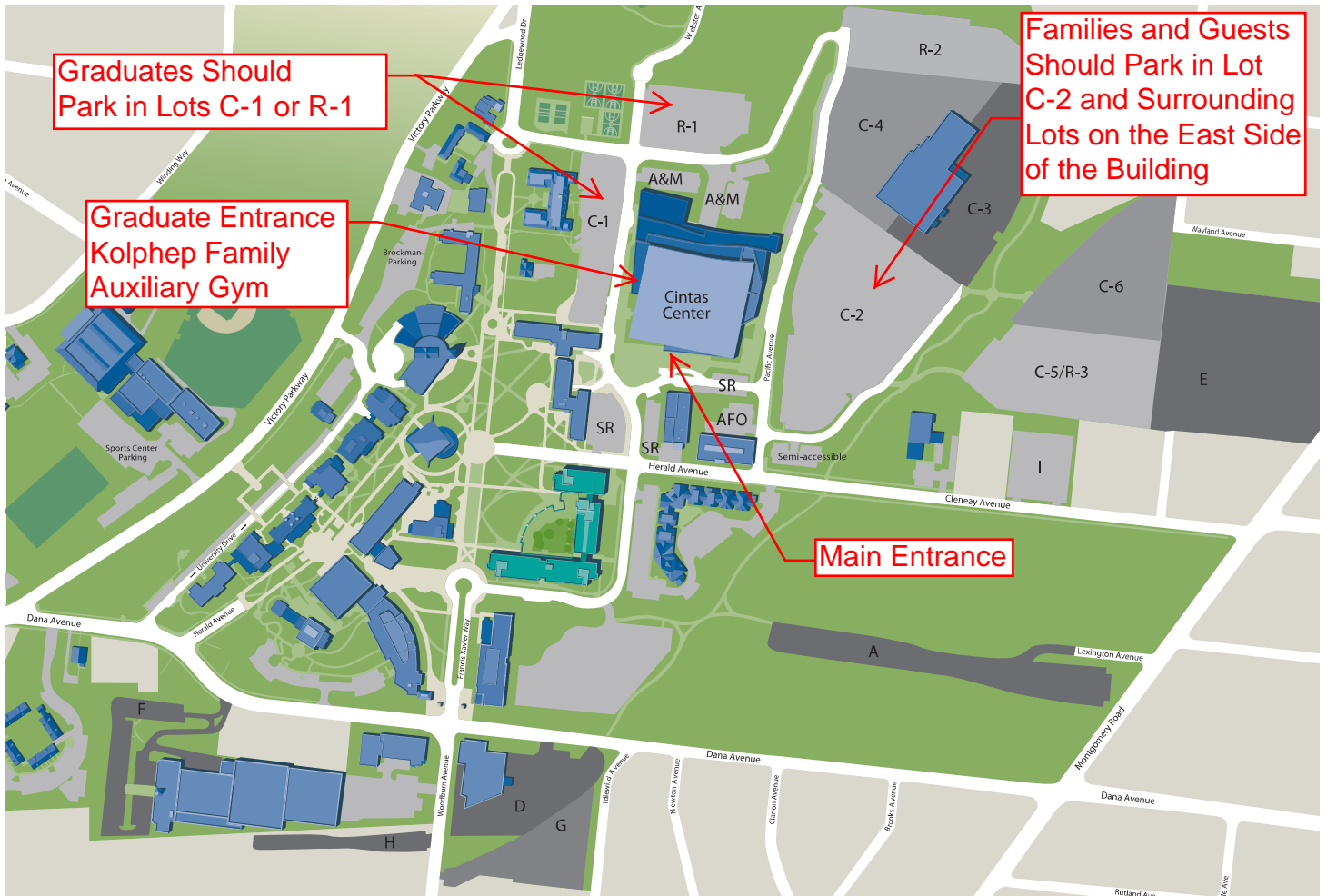
Accessible parking

Parking is available to guests with disabilities with the appropriate hangtag or license plate on a first-come, first-served basis. There are 30 marked handicap spaces in the lots surrounding the Cintas Center. Additionally, for all medium and major events, an additional 30-100 spaces are made available on a first-come, first-serve basis. These additional spaces are close to the main (south) entrance and do not involve stairs for access to the building. These spaces are clearly marked with signage that has the international disability symbol and the phrase "event only."

Parking fees

There is never a parking fee charged to attendees at a Cintas Center event.

DIRECTIONS TO CINTAS CENTER



NORTH ON I-75

Take I-75 north to the Mitchell Avenue exit (#6).
 Turn right from the exit ramp onto Mitchell Avenue.
 Follow Mitchell Avenue until it ends at Clinton Springs.
 Turn left onto Clinton Springs. Continue through the next traffic light (Reading Road).
 At Reading Road, Clinton Springs becomes Dana Avenue.
 Follow Dana Avenue to the second traffic light, Francis Xavier Way.
 Turn left onto Francis Xavier Way
 Follow Francis Xavier Way to Herald Avenue.
 Cintas Center is straight ahead.

NORTH ON I-71

Take I-71 north to the Dana Avenue/Montgomery Road exit (#5).
 Turn right from the exit ramp onto Duck Creek Road.
 At first traffic light, turn right onto Montgomery Road.
 Follow Montgomery Road. to Cleneay Avenue (third traffic light).
 Turn left onto Cleneay Avenue.
 Cintas Center is on the right side of street.

SOUTH ON I-75

Take I-75 south to the Norwood
 Lateral (SR 562) exit (#7).
 Follow the Norwood Lateral to the Reading Road. exit.
 Turn right from exit ramp onto Reading Road.
 Follow Reading Rd. to the third traffic light, Victory Parkway.
 Turn left onto Victory Parkway.
 Turn left at first traffic light, Asmann Ave. (Asmann Ave. changes to Hopkins Ave. at the city limits).
 Turn right at the first street, Webster Avenue.
 Follow Webster Avenue to Cintas Center.

SOUTH ON I-71

Take I-71 south to the Dana Avenue exit (#5).
 Turn right from the exit ramp onto Dana Avenue.
 At second traffic light, turn right onto Montgomery Road.
 Follow Montgomery Rd. to the first traffic light, Cleneay Avenue.
 Turn left onto Cleneay Avenue.
 Cintas Center is on the right side of street.
