Dear Parents,

Enclosed you will find the score reports for the End of Course Assessments taken by your child during the Spring Block (2017) at Loveland High School. By statute we are required to administer the state assessments to students graduating in 2018 and after who are enrolled in the following courses:

English Language Arts 1 (“English 9”)
English Language Arts 2 (“English 10”)
Integrated Math 1 (includes Honors and Enrichment classes)
Integrated Math 2 (includes Honors and Enrichment classes)
Biology (includes Honors)
American History (does not include AP US History)
American Government (does not include AP Government)

Students must earn a total of at least 18 points to graduate. Scores range from 1-5; a breakdown of the terms associated with the scores follows, which may be helpful in interpreting the enclosed report:

5= Advanced
4= Accelerated
3= Proficient
2= Basic
1= Limited

Points earned on these assessments fulfill one pathway to graduation. There are three pathways to graduation in Ohio. For more information on the pathways:
