

**Loveland High School Summer School 2017**  
**June 7 – July 19**  
**Guidelines and Application**

**Summer School Guidelines:**

1) Loveland High School is providing the opportunity for students to earn credits this summer using our APEX online program. Space is limited.

2) Courses may be taken for make-up credit or original credit for Physical Education only. Priority will be given to students earning make-up credit and to those currently attending LHS.

3) Cost to participate:

- Students currently enrolled at LHS
  - \$100 for each make-up course
  - \$150 for original credit - Physical Education
- Students living within the Loveland City Schools District, but not currently attending LHS
  - \$200 for each course (make-up or original)
- Courses may be purchased one at a time. Once a course is complete, another course may be purchased. **Please return the application and fee to the LHS Main Office by Wednesday, June 7.** The office is open in the summer on Monday through Thursday from 8:00am – 3:00pm. Checks should be made payable to “Loveland High School”. Course fees are **non-refundable**.

4) Students who have been working in an APEX course during the 2016-17 school year may continue in Summer School by registering and paying the Summer School fee as outlined above.

5) Students are required to report to Loveland High School on the days listed below. Excused absences can be worked out with Mr. Mitchell in advance. Once the APEX work is complete, students no longer have to report. **COURSES MUST BE COMPLETED BY WEDNESDAY, JULY 19.** Class will be held at LHS **in the Cafeteria.** Enter through the **back parking lot door (#12).** Please bring your own electronic device if possible.

June 8* ( <b>credit recovery students only</b> )	6pm-9pm
June 13 and 14	9am-noon
June 20 and 21	1pm-4pm
June 27 and 28	9am-noon
July 11 and 12	1pm-4pm
July 18 and 19	1pm-4pm

6) Students are expected to continue work from home. APEX may be accessed from any device with internet service. Once a course has been completed, students will no longer be required to report to LHS.

7) **\*At least one parent/guardian must attend a meeting with Mr. Mitchell during the first 30 minutes of either session on June 7 (PE students) OR June 8 (credit recovery students).** Parents/guardians will provide an email address to LHS in order to monitor student progress and to receive general information about summer school.
